Reminder... **DO NOT** blow or shovel snow out onto the roadways

Open Burning

Please keep the following in mind:

- No uncontained fire shall be set or maintained within 15 feet from any property line to ensure that no obnoxious odors are discharging.
- No burning during a drought condition or in a high wind condition and this shall be determined by the Mayor, Chief of Police, Zoning Officer, or the Fire Chief.
- No burning within 50 feet from any propane, gas, or oil tanks:
- No fire shall be set or maintained for the purpose of burning materials releasing obnoxious odors, dense smoke, or fly ash.

The following items should never be burned:

Garbage, plastics, Styrofoam, chemicals, any hazardous materials, tires, roofing materials, animal waste, carpet, insulation, shingles, furniture, mattresses or box springs, solvents, treated wood, paints, any type of building supplies, or vegetable waste.

No large contained or uncontained fire shall be allowed unless approved by the landowner, and a 24-hour notice is given to either the Dauphin-Middle Paxton Fire Company #1 or Dauphin County Dispatch.
