The purpose of the special public meeting was to obtain public input regarding a DCNR grant application for improvements to the Lions Club Park and the Market Square Park. Proposed improvements would include construction of an ADA walking path connecting the two parks; and installation of ADA parking, park benches, shade trees, a pavilion and modern, safe playground equipment at the Lions Club Park. Keith Heigel, of Light Heigel and Associates, presented an overview.

Thirteen (13) residents/organizations were in attendance.

A question and answer session was held. Questions included the following:

1. Locations where sidewalks would be installed.
2. Is the Borough installing a pavilion on the Lions Park Grounds?
3. What is the time table on the pavilion and the playground equipment?
4. Would parking along Canal remain available for residents?
5. Would the pavilion be available to rent?
6. Would a ramp be installed for skate boarders?
7. Would picnic tables be placed on Market Square?
8. Questions concerning vandalism
9. Would shade trees be planted?
10. Would additional parking be made available at Market Square?
11. Would two playgrounds be established - one for 2-5 years of age another 5-7 years of age
12. Concerns of speeding on Allegheny Street
13. Would mile markers be establish along the path?

Borough Council is requesting a letter of support from the Dauphin Home Association, the Middle Paxton Lions Club, the Dauphin-Middle Paxton Historical Society and the Dauphin- Middle Paxton Joint Park Authority.

Council Vice President Windish asked the listed organizations to consider a contribution. If a contribution is made, there is the possibility of matching funds for the grant.

Council will need additional input by March 19, 2018.
Application is due April 11, 2018.
