

**DAUPHIN BOROUGH**  
**RESOLUTION 2024-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF DAUPHIN, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TEMPORARILY PROHIBITING ALL OUTDOOR OPEN BURNING PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 10, PART 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF DAUPHIN BOROUGH, FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY (30) DAYS OR UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, BECAUSE OF DANGEROUSLY DRY CONDITIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 10, Part 2, of the Code of Ordinances of Dauphin Borough, regulates the open burning of any material in the Borough, and provides that Borough Council may prohibit any open burning for public safety reasons; and

**WHEREAS**, because of dangerously dry conditions in the Borough, the open burning of any material poses an immediate and substantial risk of causing or developing into an uncontrolled fire; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has asked the Borough Council to adopt and disseminate a Resolution prohibiting the open burning of any material in Dauphin Borough for a period of thirty (30) days, or until further notice, for public safety purposes.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Dauphin, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that:

1. Pursuant to Chapter 10, Part 2, of the Code of Ordinances of Dauphin Borough all open burning of any material in Dauphin Borough is hereby prohibited.
2. The open burning prohibited by this Resolution includes, but is not limited to, any fire set for the purpose of burning domestic refuse, such as trees, shrubs, leaves, rubbish, and trash.
3. Pursuant to Chapter 10, Part 2, of the Code of Ordinances of Dauphin Borough, any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate this temporary prohibition of open burning of materials in the Borough shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days.


4. The prohibition of open burning shall become effective immediately upon adoption of this Resolution and shall remain in effect for a period of thirty (30) days unless said prohibition is lifted sooner by the Mayor.


